

A special meeting of the Village of Liverpool Board of Trustees was held on December 30, 2019 at 11:45 AM at 310 Sycamore Street, Liverpool, NY 13088.

Mayor White called the meeting to order at 12:05 PM.

Temporary Appointment to Sergeant's Position

Mayor White stated that on December 21, 2019, Sergeant Unger was injured off duty. He had surgery Friday December 27, 2019 and will be out of work for 3-4 months.

Chief Morris contacted Onondaga County Personnel and inquired if the Village of Liverpool could promote a temporary sergeant based on the fact that Sergeant Unger would be out of work for 3-4 months. The new discovery and bail reform law, set to begin on January 1, 2020 states that a minimum of two supervisors are needed to comply with the new requirements.

Onondaga County Personnel advised that the Village can promote a temporary sergeant and the fact that Officer Sturtz is on the current Sergeant's list, the Village can appoint him temporary Sergeant for a period not to exceed six months.

Chief Morris spoke with Officer Sturtz and he has agreed to accept this temporary position.

Motion was made by Trustee Devendorf, seconded by Trustee Fadden to authorize the appointment of Officer Sturtz to the position of temporary Sergeant for a period not to exceed six months at Sergeant's rate of pay. Motion Passed.

Adjournment

Motion was made by Trustee Devendorf, seconded by Trustee Fadden, to adjourn the meeting. Meeting was adjourned at 12:11 PM. Motion Passed.
